Admissions Notification for NRI/PIO candidates for the Academic Year 2016-2017

As per provisions of AICTE, New Delhi, Government of India, this Institute would admit candidates to First Year degree courses in Engineering and Technology at both UG (Under Graduate) and PG (Post Graduate) levels, to either those having the status of Persons of Indian Origin(PIO), except citizens of Pakistan and Bangladesh or children of Non Resident Indians(NRI).

Definitions :

Persons of Indian Origin (PIO)

A person having foreign citizenship (except Pakistan and Bangladesh) without 'NRI' status, who holds a foreign passport at the time of sending application, consideration for admission and during the period of his/her study, and he/she or anyone /both of his/her parents or anyone/both of his/her grandparents is (or was)/are (or were) citizen(s) of India by virtue of the provisions of the Constitution of India or Sec. 2(b) of Citizenship Act, 1955 (Act No. 57 of 1955).

Non Resident Indian (NRI):

It means a candidate who is a child / ward of the person who has the NRI status as defined under section 6 of the Income Tax Act 1961.

An individual is Non-Resident when he is "not a resident" or who is "not ordinarily resident". A person is treated as "not ordinarily resident" when any of the following conditions is satisfied:

If he/she has not been resident in India in nine out of ten preceding years or if he/she has not been in India for a period of 730 days or more during the preceding seven years.

Only a person who is a NRI himself/herself may seek admission and no other candidate without NRI status would be eligible.

Admission under this category shall be made on the basis of the merit. Any seats remaining unfilled from the NRI quota will be filled as per merit (CET score) from the applicants for admission under Institute level Seats (ILS).

Eligibility criteria for NRI/PIO candidates: For Bachelor of Engineering

Candidate should have passed the HSC (Std.XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with subjects English, Physics, Mathematics and Chemistry /Biotechnology/Biology/ Technical Vocational subject

AND

Secured minimum 50 % marks in the subjects Physics, Mathematics and Chemistry/Biotechnology/Biology/Technical Vocational subject added together.

Note :

The eligibility of the candidates passing the HSC (Std. XII) or equivalent examination from a school/college/Examination Board situated outside India shall be further decided by the University Authorities to which the candidate is admitted. Hence such candidates are advised to get their eligibility verified by the respective University Authorities before seeking admission to the Engineering courses in the State of Maharashtra.

For Post graduate courses:

Candidate should have passed bachelor degree in relevant discipline from India. In case if candidate passed bachelor degree from outside India, he/she shall get their eligibility verified by the respective University Authorities before seeking admission to the Engineering courses and need to produce equivalence certificate.

More About MIT:

Location details of the college

Aurangabad is a well-known historical city, centrally located in the state of Maharashtra. The city is in close proximity to the world famous Ajanta & Ellora caves. It is linked by flights to Mumbai, Delhi, Jaipur & Udaypur. It is connected by rail to Mumbai, Delhi, Hyderabad & Manmad. By road it is widely connected all over. This city of Aurangabad is about 325 kms by road from Mumbai, and about 230 kms by road from Pune. Aurangabad is about 1250 kms from New Delhi.

Marathwada Institute of Technology is located in a nature rich area on Beed By Pass road Aurangabad. The institute is about 9 (nine) km from the International Airport, Aurangabad and is just 4 kms from CBS, Aurangabad. It has lush greenery, beautiful lawns & hills around.

Climate:

In Aurangabad district the rainy season runs from June to September. Winter is from approximately October to February and summer from March to May. The average rainfall of Aurangabad district is 734 mm, and the temperature range is about 5 to 42 degrees Celsius.
