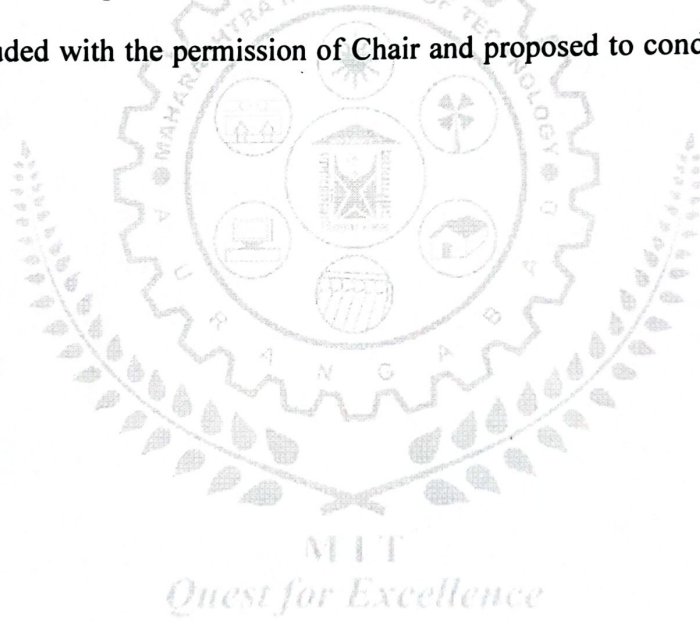
Ms. B. M. Deshmukh recommended completing the remaining accreditation related work and arranging the Mock Assessment by external members.
