1. Program Title: Heritage Walk on the Occasion of the 360th Anniversary of the Visit of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj to Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar

2. Organizing Authority: The program was jointly organized by the Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar Municipal Corporation and Indian National Trust for Art and Cultural Heritage (INTACH).

3. Program Type: Heritage Awareness / Historical Education Activity

4. Program Theme: Preservation and Awareness of Local Heritage and History

5. Date and Time: 15 March 2026 at 7:00 AM – 9:00 AM

6. Venue: Jaisingpura, starting from Makai Gate and concluding at Shri Jaysingh Shiv Temple.

7. About the Program: The Heritage Walk was organized to commemorate the 360th anniversary of the historic visit of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj to Aurangabad (present-day Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar). Historically, after the Treaty of Purandar, while traveling from Raigad Fort to Agra in 1666, Shivaji Maharaj halted at Aurangabad and stayed at the camp of Mirza Raja Jai Singh in the Jaisingpura area. Contemporary accounts mention that a large number of citizens gathered to see the great Maratha leader during his stay.
